

One JQSRT Young Scientist Award (500 euro + certificate) in the category of *Scattering & Remote Sensing* will be presented at the ELS'XIII and subsequently announced in a JQSRT Editorial.

The Scientific Organizing Committee of ELS'XIII will select the recipient based on the following criteria:

1. The nominee is younger than 36 on the first day of the meeting (this requirement can be relaxed in special cases)
2. The nominee has a presentation at ELS'XIII
3. The nominee has not received the award in the past 5 years
4. The nominee has published in JQSRT:
 - the more the better
 - paper(s) must be out or accepted on the first day of the meeting
 - at least one paper must be first-authored by the nominee
5. Scientific quality of the qualifying JQSRT publications of the nominee
Those interested to be considered for the award are encouraged to bring to the conference 5 sets of their qualifying JQSRT papers.
